FAMILY FRIENDLY DAYLIGHT TOUR

A Ghost Tour with a collection of “NOT TOO SCARY” Ghost Stories. A slow paced tour of 4 to 5 blocks with some surprises along the way, a perfect choice for anyone who wishes to retire early or get the little ones to bed.

If you’ve been unable to go on a ghost tour due to Night Time limitations—this is the TOUR FOR YOU!

A GHOSTLY ENCOUNTER

This tour has a unique twist—YOUR GUIDE IS A GHOST! In this dramatic recreation, your guide, “ghost”, will be telling the haunted tales just as they experienced them so many years ago. Travel into their Haunted Home where you may experience the same frightening encounters. This tour may be our scariest tour ever and may not be suited for young children or the faint at heart.

HAUNTED ORPHANAGE TOUR

You can enter a Haunted Orphanage and journey down the original wooden stairs to the dingy, dark dungeon where a cruel headmistress chained the children to the stone walls. On this tour you will hear stories of the other cruel treatments she inflicted on her charges, treatments that lead to the spirits lingering throughout the building today.

During your adventure, your guide will take you on a short walk around the neighborhood. You will be treated to haunted tales of the Dobbin House, Steinwehr Avenue and National Cemetery. The haunts behind the Orphanage are of special interest and will make you wonder if you wish to pass through the doors into the realm of the supernatural. **Enter if you dare!**

PRESIDENTIAL HAUNTINGS, LEGENDS AND TRIVIA

This tour is best suited for those with limited walking ability. You will only travel one-half block and seating is available during most of the tour. As the tour begins outside the Hall of Presidents you will hear haunted tales of Presidential sightings here in Gettysburg. After entering the Hall and taking a seat, your Guide will continue with more stories of past Presidents and their families. Stories of Washington DC, The White House, Presidents Homes

and other sites are explored. Little known facts, seldom told stories are infused with some pretty amazing ghost stories of these men who have led our nation. **(This tour is scheduled to begin summer of 2010)**

THE JENNIE WADE TOUR

Our second walking tour proceeds through the South side of town. This tour traverses the area of East Cemetery Hill. You will stop for curious tales of ghostly soldiers, heartbroken women, Poltergeists and other assorted Ghostly activity.

You will enter through the same door, where a bullet passed on July 3, 1863 and killed Jennie Wade, making her the only civilian to die during the battle of Gettysburg. The Ghostly tales of this house have been recorded in numerous books and holds the proud distinction of being on the Travel Channels list of haunted houses. In October 2008 it was featured on television's "Most Haunted", and was singled out by the lead investigator as the **"MOST HAUNTED IN GETTYSBURG"**.

The stories alone are chilling enough but now through modern technology provided by Ghost Researchers, we have evidence that cold spots roam the stairs and rooms, chains swing freely for no reason, rocking chairs move when vacant. The voice of a small boy calls out "Play With Me", A man calls from the cellar, "We're down here".

So if you are "dying" to enter any of these haunted sites, we can accommodate you. Please bring your camera, the ghosts are photo friendly.

NEW IN 2010 **FIRESIDE GHOST STORIES**

A NO Walking Event

This **NEW EVENT** takes place on Friday Evenings beginning June 18th in the Courtyard in the "Old Gettysburg Village" (777 Baltimore Street—Opposite the entrance of the Travelodge). You will be mesmerized for 1 hour 15 minutes as your storyteller spins tales and legends while you gather around the campfire and relax in the secluded confines of the Village. Your guide will take you on a "Chill" ride around Gettysburg, THE MOST HAUNTED TOWN IN AMERICA.

This is perfect for those who must limit their walking or just want to relax at the end of a busy day. Bench seating will be provided. Additional programs will be held Sat., May 29th and Sunday, May 30th, Sun., June 27th, Sun., July 4th and Sun., Sept. 5th. You must put this new event on your Ghostly Must Do List, so reserve early by calling (717) 334-6296.

MIDNIGHT IN A HAUNTED HOUSE

For those looking for the “ULTIMATE GHOSTLY ADVENTURE,” we have a dare for you, **“Midnight in a Haunted House”**. This challenge takes you into the **Jennie Wade House** where you will travel room by room with a Ghost Storyteller who will relay to you the HAUNTING TALES of this mysterious house. Eventually you will find yourself in the cellar where Jennie Wade’s body lay for 36 hours on July 3-4, 1863. Your time in the cellar will include a presentation by a Medium who will discuss the haunting at the house or a Guest Speaker who works with Ghost Investigative Teams in the House.

Did we forget to tell you that the **LIGHTS GO OUT AT MIDNIGHT!** So Beware!

Midnight in the Jennie Wade House is held every Saturday night, March 20th through November 20th. Tour Times: 10:45, 11:10 or 11:35. All groups will be inside at midnight.

FRIDAY NIGHTS are just as exciting as we hold our **“Midnight Orphanage Tour”**. Our Medium or Guest Speaker will be in the cellar of a Haunted Orphanage where the children were chained to the walls or locked in the dungeon in the dark, overnight. While in the orphanage cellar you will be amazed at the stories you’ll hear and maybe even have an experience of your own.

Part of tour will be spent outside with our Ghost Storytellers for tales from the “Other Side”. Depending on which group you’re in you will be in either the Orphanage cellar or Old Gettysburg Village Courtyard at Midnight.

The tour begins @ 10:45 Friday Nights March 19th through November 19th.
