Start the day at **Eisenhower National Historic Site**. Tour Ike and Mamie's home, grounds and show barn that housed the President's award-winning black angus cattle. A true gentleman's farm.



Next up is a stop at **Reid's Orchard & Winery**. Visit their Home Winery Tasting room where you can sample wine or hard cider in this peaceful setting. Make your visit more special with a boxed lunch, fruit & cheese plate, antipasto platter, dessert, or their signature chocolate truffles.

Drive through the lovely Adams county countryside to **Oyler's Organic Farms**. This sixth generation farm is Pennsylvania certified organic. Take a tour, learn how to make applesauce, sauerkraut, or the basics of home canning. A tasty farm to table lunch would be an excellent addition to your visit.



Family owned and operated for more than 60 years, **Hollabaugh Bros. Fruit Farm & Market** is a local favorite. Take a guided wagon ride, pick some apples, sample apple cider, taste a home-made apple cider donut and shop in their 4,000 sq. foot retail store.
