#### DAY ONE

Visit the Seminary Ridge Museum and stand on the very grounds where the battle began on July 1, 1863. Look out the same windows Union soldiers used, as the Confederate Army charged the hills. Tour the museum and see artifacts, mini movies and displays of war time experiences.







Next a Licensed Guide will board your group's bus for a two hour tour of the battlefield. The guides knowledge and expertise will bring the battle to life, as your group visits the Virginia Monument, General Lee will appear to address the group in full regalia. A sight to see for sure!



Enjoy a hearty lunch at the Historic Dobbin House.

After lunch, tour the Jennie Wade House Museum. The home where the only civilian was killed during the three day battle. Hear how she lost her life and how her family had to make their way to safety. You will follow the same route the family traveled as the battle raged around them.

### DAY TWO

The Gettysburg National Military Park Visitor Center, will start your day. There you will see the Film narrated by actor Morgan Freeman, view the famous Cyclorama painting showcasing Pickett's Charge and walk through the museum where artifacts, videos and interactive stations reintroduce you to the battle.

Next, tour the Shriver House. Home of the Shriver Family, who's brush with the battle would forever change their lives. See how the home looked before, during and after the battle, from Garret to Cellar. The guides will share how the confederates took over the home and left their mark on the family.



For Lunch, get your fill at General Pickett's Buffet!

Next, walk upstairs to the Battle Theatre where a Union Soldier will share his experiences during the battle of Gettysburg. Hear his take on the attack and what happened to the town of Gettysburg on those fateful three days!





Finish your journey, by visiting the Gettysburg National Cemetery,

where our nations brave were laid to rest. Stand on the very ground where so many would journey to hear President Lincoln give the Gettysburg Address.
