Start your visit at the Gettysburg National
Military Park Visitor Center. The activities in this
state of the art facility includes a museum, with
11 exhibit galleries, the inspiring film "A New
Birth of Freedom" and world famous
Cyclorama. These activities provide visitors with
an excellent introduction to the
Battle of Gettysburg.





Next tour the Eisenhower National
Historic site. Join a Park Ranger as they
orient everyone on a short tour of the
property before visiting the home of our
34th President. Be sure to allow time for a
self-guided stroll of the grounds to
complete the visit.

Enjoy a delicious meal at the Dobbin House which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. You're sure to love the food and historic ambiance within this notable Gettysburg location.





A licensed guide will board your bus for a 2-hour battlefield tour. The guides knowledge and expertise will bring the battle to life as you are led through the 3-days battle. Be sure to bring your camera!

The Jennie Wade House. Tour the home where the only civilian was killed during the battle. Jennie was kneading dough in the kitchen when a rifle bullet pierced two doors and claimed her life. Knowledgeable guides in period attire will lead your group through the history of the home.





A tour and tasting await you at the Mason Dixon Distillery. New to Gettysburg in early 2016. Small batch handcrafted spirits, great food and relaxed atmosphere make it a must stop on your itinerary.

Opened in July 2013, The Gettysburg Seminary Ridge Museum houses four stories of artifacts, photographs, wax figure depictions of the wounded and more. This historic building was used as a field hospital for soldiers of both armies during the battle.





Your group is sure to enjoy an abundant family style meal at Hickory Bridge Farm for lunch or dinner.
