



THE BILLY YANK DAY TRIP

Two great armies met in Gettysburg on July 1, 1863. By July 4th, their presence would leave it's permanent mark upon the town and the land. Step where men fought and died. Visit where some never left and leave Gettysburg with a better understanding of how this battle would be forever remembered throughout history!



Upon arrival the group will visit the scene of the first days' battle and tour through the Seminary Ridge Museum. As they walk through the building that saw the battle unfold and later became a military hospital.

Depart for lunch at one of the historic restaurants in town. Afterwards, return to the Visitor Center, where a Licensed Battlefield Guide will board your bus for a two hour tour, focusing on the Union perspective.



Next, visit the Gettysburg Heritage Center, and learn about the impact of the battle upon the town and the aftermath of three days of fighting.



The group will finally stop in Emmitsburg, Maryland for dinner at the Historic Carriage House Inn. After dinner enjoy a living history presentation with a Union Soldier, General and his wife or President Lincoln. Surely a trip to remember!
