

THE REBEL YELL DAY TRIP

Two great armies met in Gettysburg on July 1, 1863. By July 4th, their presence would leave it's permanent mark upon the town and the land. Walk upon the same ground where the Rebel Yell was heard and where these two forces would clash, causing Gettysburg to be the 'high water mark' for the South, during the Civil War.



Upon arrival, your group will be immersed into American History at the Gettysburg National Military Park Visitor Center. They will spend the morning viewing artifacts from the battle and visit the famous Cyclorama depicting the last massive assault in Gettysburg.

Depart for lunch at one of the historic restaurants in town. Afterwards, return to the Visitor Center, where a Licensed Battlefield Guide will board your bus for a two hour tour, focusing on the Confederate perspective.





Next, visit the Gettysburg Heritage Center, and learn about the impact of the battle upon the town and the aftermath of the three day fight.

The group will depart for one of the area's oldest taverns and enjoy dinner, where Robert E. Lee dined during his retreat on July 4th, 1863.
