Suggested Itinerary for a 4-day/ 3-night visit to participate in the Gettysburg Heritage Trails program to earn the associated patches, segments and medals and have some fun along the way!

Day One:

• Arrive in Gettysburg and set up camp at the location of your choice. Some scouts opt for the free camping that is provided at McMillan Woods through the National Park Service or allow us to book campsites at one of our area's many beautiful campgrounds.

Day Two:

- Take the Historic Gettysburg Trail Hike beginning at the Gettysburg National Military Park Visitor Center.
- Enjoy a self-guided tour of the National Soldier's Cemetery complete with guide maps.
- March into General Pickett's Buffet for a delicious dinner.
- Visit the famous American Civil War Wax Museum
- Take a ghost tour which guides you into the Haunted Orphanage for an evening of mystery.
- Return to your camp site.

Day Three:

- Hike the Billy Yank Trail which begins at the GNMP Visitor Center. This is a 10-mile hike which takes approximately 6 hours to complete.
- Enjoy an All You Can Eat Pizza buffet dinner.
- Visit the Gettysburg Diorama & History Center for a bird's eye view of the battlefield.
- The world famous Jennie Wade House Museum is your last stop in today's schedule.
- Return to your camp site for a good night's rest.

Day Four:

- Hike the Johnny Reb Trail which begins at the GNMP Visitor Center. This is a 4-mile hike and takes approximately 2.5 hours to complete.
- Refresh your troops at the Refreshment Saloon for lunch, located right inside the GNMP Visitor Center.
- Depart by shuttle from the GNMP Visitor Center for the Eisenhower Farm Tour.
- Return to your campsite to break camp and head for home.
