Here, you can experience a wide variety of authentic WWII vehicles, uniforms and artifacts in realistic dioramas and exhibits that portray, not just the battlefield, but the Homefront as well.

After an onsite boxed lunch, we'll head out for a tour of the home and farm of President Dwight D. Eisenhower, supreme commander of the allied forces during WWII. Here you will enjoy a partially guided tour of the home and grounds and hear tales of visits from influential world leaders such as English WWII hero Winston Churchill.
