Baltimore Street Scavenger Hunt

DIRECTIONS - START AT MR. G'S ICE TREAM ON BALTIMORE ST, WALK NORTH ON BALTIMORE ST. WHEN YOU GET TO HIGH STREET CROSS THE STREET. WALK BACK DOWN BALTIMORE ST DOWN THE HILL SOUTH TROSS OVER TO MR G'S ICE TREAM AND WALK SOUTH UP THE HILL.

- 1.1 HAVE A SWEET TREAT ON MY SIGNS. (HINT I HAVE BULLET HOLES IN MY SIDE, NEXT TO ONE OF MY SIGNS.)
- 2. I HAVE MY HAND RAISED DELIVERING THE GETTYSBURG ADDRESS. (HINT THIS BIG BUILDING HAS 6 STONE PILLARS ON ITS FRONT.
- 3. FIND A SIGN FOR A BOWLING ALLEY HANGING ABOVE THIS HOUSE'S DOOR, CHINT, IN THE PAST BOWLING WAS CALLED TENPIN. IN 1863 THERE WAS A TENPIN ALLEY BEHIND THE HOUSE.)
- 4. MORE THAN 100 BULLET HOLES ARE IN MY BUILDING'S SIDE. I ALSO SAW LINCOLN WALK PAST ME ON THE WAY TO DELIVER THE GETTYSBURG ADDRESS. (HINT. THERE IS A BEAUTIFUL GARDEN IN FRONT OF ME WITH A STREAM.)
- 5. I WAS THE ONLY CIVILIAN TO BE KILLED DURING THE BATTLE WHILE MAKING BAKED GOODS FOR THE UNION SOLDIERS. CHINT I NOW HAVE A STATUE IN FRONT OF THE HOUSE WHERE I WAS KILLED.)
- 6. MY BUILDING HOUSED ORPHANS FROM 1866-1877 WHOSE FATHERS DIED IN THE WAR. CHINT THE NAME OF MY BUILDING IS PAINTED ON MY SIDE NEAR THE SECOND-FLOOR WINDOW.)
- 7. LINCOLN WASN'T THE ONLY PRESIDENT TO VISIT GETTYSBURG. YOU CAN FIND MY FAMOUS QUOTE ON MY STATUE'S BASE. (HINT BEFORE MY PRESIDENCY. I WAS THE SUPREME ALLIED COMMANDER IN WORLD WAR II.)
- 8. WE SIT HIGH ON OUR HORSES. ONE OF US LOOKS TOWARD GETTYSBURG. THE OTHER LOOKS TOWARD THE NATIONAL CEMETERY. (HINT JUST LOOK AT THE GIANT TREE ON THE HILL STRAIGHT AHEAD TO YOUR LEFT FROM WHERE YOU STAND YOU CAN'T MISS US.)





- 1. JOHN WINEBRENNER HOUSE THIS BUILDING HOUSED CIVILIANS IN ITS BASEMENT DURING THE BATTLE.
 RECENTLY A WELL WAS ALSO DISCOVERED OUTSIDE DURING RENOVATIONS.
 LOCATION 404 BALTIMORE ST.
- 2. <u>GETTYSBURG LIBRARY</u>- NOT THE ORIGINAL SPOT WHERE LINCOLN GAVE THE ADDRESS. LINCOLN DELIVERED THE ADDRESS AT THE EVERGREEN CEMETERY WHICH IS NEXT TO THE NATIONAL CEMETERY HERE IN GETTYSBURG. THE EXACT SPOT HE GAVE THE ADDRESS IS VERY NEAR WHERE JENNIE WADE'S STATUE SITS. LOCATION 140 BALTIMORE ST.
- 3. THE SHRIVER HETTIE SHRIVER WOULD FLEE HER HOME WITH HER TWO KIDS ON THE FIRST DAY'S BATTLE. HETTIE AND THE KIDS WOULD RETURN TO FIND THE HOUSE IN SHAMBLES. HISTORIC HOUSE TOURS ARE AVAILABLE.

- 4. THE SWENEY HOUSE KNOWN TODAY AS THE FARNSWORTH HOUSE, THIS BUILDING BEARS MARKINGS OF THE URBAN COMBAT THAT TOOK PLACE IN GETTYSBURG STREETS. AFTER THE BATTLE, THE OWNER HARVEY SWENEY WROTE A GREAT ACCOUNT OF LINCOLNS PASSING BY THE HOUSE TO GIVE THE GETTYSBURG ADDRESS. LOCATION 401 BALTIMORE ST.
- 5. <u>JENNIE WADE HOUSE</u> MARY VIRGINIA "JENNIE" WADE WAS 20 YEARS OLD AT THE TIME OF THE BATTLE AND IS CREDITED WITH BEING THE ONLY CIVILIAN KILLED DURING THE BATTLE. HISTORIC HOUSE TOURS ARE AVAILABLE, LOCATION 548 BALTIMORE ST.
- 6. SOLDIER NATIONAL HOMESTEAD THIS BUILDING WAS FIRST USED AS HEADQUARTERS BY UNION GENERAL OLIVER O' HOWARD DURING THE BATTLE, AFTER THE BATTLE, IT WAS A HOSPITAL AND THEN LATER AN ORPHANAGE.

LOCATION 777 BALTIMORE ST.

7. EISENHOWER STATUE - FORMER PRESIDENT DWIGHT D. EISENHOWER, AND FORMER FIRST LADY MAMIE EISENHOWER LOVED GETTYSBURG SO MUCH THAT THEY PURCHASED A FARM THAT SITS SOUTHWEST OF GETTYSBURG. SEASONAL TOURS ARE AVAILABLE.

8. <u>EQUESTRIAN STATUES</u> - DID YOU KNOW THERE ARE EIGHT TOTAL EQUESTRIAN STATUES ON THE GETTYSBURG BATTLEFIELD? THE NAME EQUESTRIAN MEANS HORSE RIDING. THESE TWO STATUES ARE UNION MAJOR GENERAL DLIVER DTIS HOWARD AND WINFIELD SCOTT HANCOCK.
